The above mentioned Toasts are as they should be printed on the Toast Lists for all Chapter Installations and other Royal Arch Dinners. They are correctly described and are placed in the order in which they should be proposed.

Other Toasts may follow as the Chapter wishes

Toast 1 and 2 should be introduced with the word “Companions”, and may be made whilst waiters/waitresses are still in the room.

At Toast 3 it is recommended that the full address to those present is made by the proposer of the Toast, i.e. “Most Excellent Grand Superintendent/Deputy Grand Superintendent/Second and Third Provincial Grand Principals, Grand Officers, Provincial Grand Officers, Excellent Companions and Companions”. Following which other Toasts can then be introduced with minimal preamble such as “Your Excellencies, Excellent Companions and Companions” or “Excellent Companions and Companions”

If the National Anthem is sung or played in the Chapter it should not be repeated at the Festive Board

The Honorifics (printed in italics) should be printed on the Toast List but omitted when verbally proposing the Toast.
